



Abstract Submission Guideline

Overview

The 10th GCC Medical Students Conference invites undergraduate medical students to submit abstracts presenting their research and case reports conducted under faculty supervision. The conference provides a platform for scientific exchange, constructive feedback, and networking across GCC and international institutions. Accepted abstracts will be considered for poster or oral presentation.

Eligibility

- Submission is open to undergraduate medical students enrolled in GCC and international universities at the time of the conference.
- Each abstract must include at least one faculty supervisor as co-author.
- Submissions must be through the conference portal only, no submissions will be accepted through emails.
- Each student may present one poster only as first and presenting author.

Formatting Requirements

- **Word Limit:** Maximum **350 words** (excluding title and acknowledgments).
- **Do not** include references, figures, or duplicate submissions.

Abstract Structure

- **Abstract Title:**
 - Capitalize Each Word (avoid abbreviations).
- **Authors and Affiliations:**
 - List all authors in this format:
-Name Surname¹, Name Surname²,...
 - Use superscript numbers to indicate institutions.
 - For authors from the same institution, write the city and country once at the end:
-Department, Institute, City, Country¹, Department, Institute, City, Country²,
- **Sections:**
 - *Introduction*
 - *Aims & Objectives*
 - *Methods*
 - *Results*
 - *Conclusion*
- **Keywords:**
 - Provide **3 – 5 keywords** describing your study.

Submission Process

- Submit abstracts via the conference submission portal.
- Submission deadline: **Feb 15th 2026**.
- Authors will be notified by the **end of February 2026** regarding the status of their submission.
- Notification will specify acceptance and presentation type (oral or poster).
- Detailed presentation guidelines will follow upon acceptance.
