Poster Design Guidelines

The authors should prepare posters according to the following rules:

1. The poster format should adhere to the following:

- a. One page of **A1 size** on a foam base
- b. The title should be bold
- c. The author and supervisor's names should follow the title
- d. Single line spacing should be used
- e. The footer should contain the academic year and semester
- f. The date should be typed at the bottom right corner
- g. The authors may adjust the text and the poster layout accordingly

2. It should contain the following sections in brief:

- a. Title
- b. Authors with University/Institute., Country, and email addresses for all [corr. author will have *]
- c. Abstract
- d. Keywords: max 3
- e. Problem statement & Motivation e.g., What problem does this work address? Why does it matter in a sports context?
- f. Methodology
- g. Results & Key Findings
- h. It should contain project phase's procedures and design with graphic illustrations (block diagrams, prototypes, etc.)
- i. Conclusion and Future Work
- j. Reference - Minimum 3 to maximum 4 references [author(s) can reduce font sizes for Ref.]
- k. Acknowledgement

3. It should be free of spelling and grammatical mistakes
