Mission

The purpose of the Annual UAEU students' Conference is to promote undergraduate research and creative activities conducted by undergraduate students In the United Arab Emirates through their universities and colleges, it is also an opportunity for students to show case their research capabilities and endeavors. Students' participation is welcomed in all fields and disciplines.

Goals

- 1. Fostering undergraduate research among United Arab Emirates Universities students;
- 2. Having the experience of presenting at a research conference in a friendlier environment;
- 3. Gaining a new appreciation for open research questions in other universities perhaps leading to richer inter-Colleges/interdisciplinary research in the future;
- 4. Giving students a deeper understanding of the topics in their major through explaining them to conference attendees;
- Highlighting the research that the top scholars and their advisors are doing in each UAE
 University.



Rules

The 2016 conference is open to all Undergraduate Students in the United Arab Emirates Universities. The best projects will be rewarded by UAE University.

- 1. Only presently registered and active undergraduate students (selected by their university/college) are eligible to present in the 2016 conference day.
- 2. Each University is eligible to submit <u>up to three projects</u> including <u>Oral</u> presentations or <u>Posters.</u>
- 3. All contributions either Oral or Posters will be presented in the conference day:
 - a. Oral Presentations: 15 minutes
 - b. Posters show case, students should submit their abstracts prior to the final presentation (100cm high x 140cm width).
- 4. Each university/college is required to <u>appoint one faculty member by 22th of March</u>

 2016 to communicate with the UAEU conference organizing committee.
- 5. Each university/college is responsible to select and submit the best three projects before 13th April 2016.
- 6. All participants will receive a certificate.

Attendees

The 2016 conference is open to all UAE undergraduate students and teachers, as well as officially invited people. Visitors and guests will receive an official letter on due time.



Abstracts

All selected students must submit their final projects (presentations or posters) by 13th of April 2016. Any project submitted after the due date will be rejected.

- 2. Posters for men should be delivered in building H4, room 1032 or room 1031.
- 3. Posters for women should be delivered in building C5, room 2013.

Registration

Selection Procedures

Each college appoints its own internal committee to select the <u>three</u> best projects (oral presentation or posters) that represent their respective university/college on the conference day.

Presentation Guidelines

Oral presentation

- Presentations will be scheduled into 15 minutes blocks
- Presentations should be in English
- Projectors and laptops are provided
- All students must send their presentation files and posters to the organizing committee before the 13th of April, 2016
- Any required media or special equipment should be coordinated with the organizing committee ahead of time

Poster Presentations

- Landscape orientation (90 cm H) x (140 cm W)
- Poster hanging materials will be provided
- Tables will be provided for experimental projects
- Posters must be readable from 2 meters away
- Presenters must be available to discuss their poster during the allotted session and time
- Poster should include:
 - presentation title
 - o student name
 - o research advisor name
 - university, college and department names

Experiential projects and media projects (video or film) will be presented during the posters session and must be no more than 15 minutes (video or films).
