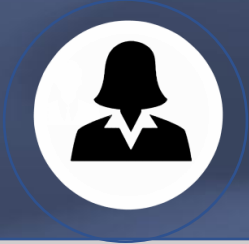

Reflective Practice and the Conceptualization of Implicit Theories of Counseling and Psychotherapy with Psychology Faculty Members.

ABSTRACT: This research qualitatively characterized the subjective concept of counseling and psychotherapy of faculty working at a public university in the United Arab Emirates (Middle East) and how they embraced this concept when teaching psychology-related courses.

Using Grounded Theory Analysis as a general methodological framework, this study was based on an analysis of fourteen face-to-face in-depth interviews with psychology faculties. The inquiry intended to discover how interviewees reflected on their counseling practice and how they adapted this reflection to their teaching context in the UAE. Additionally, it aimed to understand the specific changes these professionals have implemented to enhance their counseling and psychotherapeutic practice to fulfill the mental health needs of psychology students and patients. The results revealed that the interviewees regarded the teaching of psychology and counseling as a relational process that leads to personal growth, both for the student/patient and the faculty members/therapist implying that both cultural and intersubjective dimensions should be considered.

In conclusion, all the psychologists interviewed stated that the relational and ethnographic dimensions of counseling should be incorporated into training psychologists in the UAE as aspects of the concept of culture.

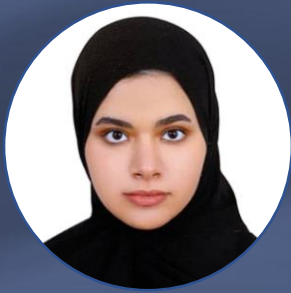

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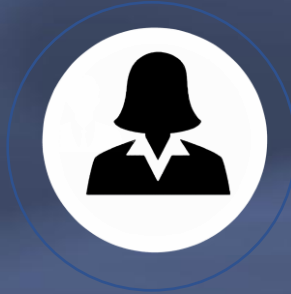

ABSTRACT: Since the unification of the United Arab Emirates in 1971, Al Ain has emerged from a predominantly desert region to a highly urbanized modern city. Today, Al Ain boasts an extensive freeway system, parks and tree lined avenues, three major shopping centers, traditional souqs, service industries, universities, medical facilities, and government infrastructure. The aim of the research project is to investigate the intensive urban growth in Al Ain by bringing into focus the development of residential areas, population growth, and the expansion of the transportation system. Secondary sources such as peer reviewed journal articles, data from government websites, and Landsat imagery are analyzed to demonstrate the urbanization process. The findings show that the urbanization process in Al Ain has included significant development of residential areas that attract and house the citizen and expatriate population. Natural Disaster Management in the United Arab Emirates: Towards Effective Policies and Practices

ABSTRACT: Natural disasters have been on the rise globally due to natural and anthropogenic processes. During the last two decades, the United Arab Emirates (UAE) has been impacted by an increase in natural disasters including earthquakes, landslides, and floods. The UAE established the National Emergency Crisis and Disasters Management Authority in 2009 to reduce the impacts of hazards through proactive measures taken before a disaster occurs. The aim of the research is to identify effective solutions for managing natural disasters in the UAE as part of an emergency management framework. Primary data was collected using semi-structured interviews with government personnel involved in devising policies that address natural disasters and experts that conducted research on the impact of natural disasters on communities. Secondary data was collected from peer reviewed journal articles and government websites that address issues related to natural disasters in the UAE. The findings demonstrate that a comprehensive natural disaster management framework includes (1) identifying the most prominent types of natural disasters in the UAE and addressing their related effects; (2) developing appropriate infrastructure and emergency planning procedures; and (3) conducting further research that examines natural disasters in the UAE to produce policies and practices for more effective disaster management.

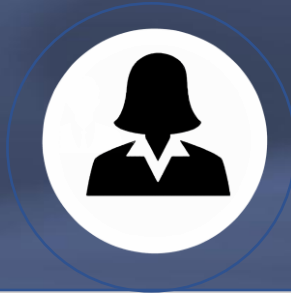
